BlockWork is the Salisbury program to improve the city one block at a time. This year the focus is on the 900 Block of Horah, near Livingstone College. The date is Oct. 25, also the national "Make a Difference" day. Annually over 100 people show up ready to work at a variety of projects including pruning and landscape work, to repair of porches and lots of painting. Not much skill needed! Bring your dog, with or without costume, for a "Scary Dog Walk"! Gather at Centennial Park (corner Stanley and Wiley) at 5 PM.


The dogs (and owners) will parade throughout the neighborhood. Always such fun! P.S. - no dogs, please, at the Children's parade on Oct. 31.
