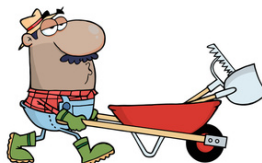


## From the President:

Halloween is coming! Time for Giggles and Ghosts, Candy and Costumes!

On Tuesday, October 31st, go to school or work, and then hurry home to put on your favorite costume and meet all your friends at 5:00 PM in the 200 block of Mitchell Avenue. (The street will be closed from Fulton Street through the 400 block of Mitchell to keep our trick-or-treaters safe.)

We'll start with the Costume Parade, led by a real live Police officer (that's NOT a costume!) in the patrol car. PLEASE, no dogs at this parade; they will have their own Doggie Parade on Saturday, October 28th at 5:00 PM at Centennial Park.

Then choose the costume category that best describes your costume and join that group (look for the signs). Categories are Cutest (ages 3 and under); Scariest; Most Original; Best Movie/TV; Best Literary/History; Most Eco-Friendly (best use of recycled materials); Best Duo or Group; Best Float (decorated wagon or other wheeled item). Awards will be given to the top three costumes in each category.

Early voting is from Oct. 19 through Nov. 4, only at the Rowan County Elections Office, 1935 Jake Alexander Blvd W, Suite D10 (Old Salisbury Mall). Week Day Hours: Mon-Fri 8 AM – 5 PM; Saturday, Nov. 4: 8 AM -1 PM.

Nov. 7: Vote in your precinct (Fulton Heights votes on the lower level of Maupin Avenue Presbyterian Church)

This is the election for Salisbury City Council. All Five seats are up for election. There are 13 candidates. Historically, there is very low turnout for this election, so YOUR vote counts! You can learn more about each candidate at the Forum on October 23 in the Crystal Lounge area of the Keppel at Catawba College. In addition, the Salisbury Post is running interesting interviews with each candidate.
