What a strange winter! It's nice to have spring (again!)

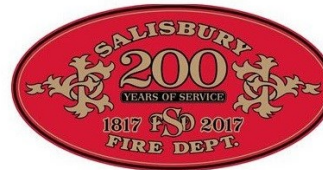
The early spring weather gave many of us an opportunity to do some yard work. More to come!!
