NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH NOTES

Neighborhood Watch means all neighbors watching for each other and each other's property. Let's keep our eyes and ears open for each other!

Typical summertime crime is aimed at bicycles and lawnmowers. Keep them stored when not in use, out of sight, if possible, and if they "sprout legs" and walk away, CALL 911, and make out a report! Your report may help the police see a pattern. This is IMPORTANT. Make the call! 911.

If you are going on vacation, let a trusted neighbor know, so they can be more watchful of your property. Give that neighbor information of how to contact you, if there is a problem at your house while you are away.

Also, when you call the police for an incident in progress, give exact information like "In the alley behind this address, give a description of the activity, a description of individuals involved (clothing, size, appearance, etc.)." If you do not want the police to come to your house, tell the operator, "Do not come to my house". "Call me back for further information". But MAKE THE CALL IMMEDIATELY! Don't tell a neighbor first! CALL 911!
