Do You Know?

SALISBURY - Fulton Heights has a wide variety of wildlife, thanks in part to our mature trees and nearby water. In the evenings, you may hear the distinctive call of our resident Barred Owls with their hoots often described as, "Who cooks for you? Who cooks for you all?"

Sadly, one of the barred owls was recently found dead in the 500 block of Maupin Avenue. It appeared to have died defending its young. Two days later, neighbors found an owlet hiding in their yard. One of the neighbors said, "I was greeted to these big eyes and fluff." The couple, both avid birdwatchers, said they immediately recognized that the young owl needed help.

They contacted the Raptor Center in Huntersville, which took in the owlet. The couple named him "Winky." According to the Raptor Center, Winky was dehydrated and hungry but is now doing well. He is practicing flying and will be released once he has fully recovered.

The remaining parent has stayed in the nest and continues to care for Winky's two owlet siblings, who are now learning to fly and find food, the couple said.

Barred owls typically mate for life. Over the next four to six months, the young owls will mature and move on to establish their own territory, usually within a six-mile radius. The surviving adult will most likely remain in Fulton Heights and find a new mate before the next breeding season in late winter. Let us hope so. It's always a thrill to hear their varied hooting calls at dusk.
